## PRESS NOTE

A number of Voluntary Hindi Organisations in different parts of the country have been conducting Hindi Examinations for a long time. In order that the candidates who pass these examinations become eligible for employment in Government service for which Hindi qualifications are prescribed, the Government of India on the recommendations of the Hindi Shiksha Samiti and with the concurrence of the Union Public Service Commission, accorded recognition to the various examinations of these organisations and a press Note was accordingly issued in 1960. The recognition of some of these examinations was extended from time to time till the end of 31st December, 1969, vide ministry of Education Press Note No. F, 7-50/66-H. 1 dated the 15th May, 1967.

The Hindi Shiksha Samiti which advises the Government of India on matters relating to propagation and development of Hindi in its 21st meeting held on the 19th and 20th April, 1969, had recommended that the examinations which are being conducted by these voluntary organisations for the last 10 years and which have been recognised by the Government of India for the last five years may be granted recognition on a permanent basis subject to the condition that such institutions should continue to be inspected every year and in the event of any grave irregularities being detected in the course of the inspection action may be taken to withdraw the recognition. This recommendation of the Hindi Shiksha Samiti has been accepted by the Government of India and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission the Government of India have decided to grant permanent recognition to the various examinations as shown in the Annexure.

It may, however, be clarified that recognition to these examinations has been accorded only in regard to the standard of Hindi prescribed in the equivalent Hindi examination and it is not to be treated as equivalent to the full-fledged Certificate/Degree of the examination to which it has been equated.
